

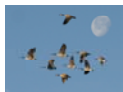
The Book of 2 Peter
Chapter 1 Part 1, Verses 1-11
“Make Your Call and Election Sure”

There once was a Goose who had been wounded in flight, and had landed in a Farm that contained a barnyard full of chickens.



He began to play with the chickens, eat with the chickens and eventually the Goose started thinking that he was a chicken.

One beautiful afternoon, a flight of Geese flew over the barnyard, on their migration back to their home.



As they passed overhead, they gave the familiar “**Honk**”, which caught the attention of the Goose down in the barnyard.

There was something that stirred up inside of the heart of that Goose, there was something calling him out of the barnyard into the skies.

He started to flap his wings that he had not been using, he jumped up from the ground and flew a few feet into the air before falling back to the ground.

By remaining on the ground, hanging out with the chickens, he missed the call that would fulfill the purpose for which he had been created

Is that us this morning?

- ☞ **Have you been wounded?** Have You been hurt by people or by life?
- ☞ **Instead of soaring into the sky,** have you been hanging out with the chickens, living the way a chicken lives?
- ☞ **This morning,** a call is going out to you from the One who made you...

“Time to soar, time to fulfill the purpose for which you were created...”

- ☞ **Stop listening** to what everyone else says about you.
- ☞ **Stop listening to the enemy** that says “*You are not ever going to be good enough*”
- ☞ **Stop hanging out** with creatures of the earth, and begin to soar with the Creatures of the Air!

Jeremiah 1:5

“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you

Romans 8:29-30

29 For whom He foreknew, **He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son**, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

This morning, Peter is going to instruct and encourage us to fulfill the purpose for which we were called by Jesus for:

2 Peter

1 Simon Peter, a **bondservant** and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:

Peter speaks of something that he knows about first hand from his own experience, that of becoming a “**Bondservant**” of Jesus.

Exodus 21:2-6

2 If you buy a **Hebrew servant**, **he shall serve six years**; and **in the seventh he shall go out free** and pay nothing

5 But **if the servant plainly says, “I love my master**, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,’

6 then his master shall bring him to the judges. **He shall also bring him to the door**, or to the doorpost, and **his master shall pierce his ear with an awl**; and **he shall serve him forever**.

Have you discovered how wonderful it is to dwell in Jesus house? Even though He is the master and you are his servant, He doesn’t treat you like a slave, he treats you like a Son or a Daughter. You find that you never want to leave His house, but you just want to be near Him forever!

Psalms 84:10 David said:

A single day in your courts (Lord) is better than a thousand anywhere else!

Psalms 23:6

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And **I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever**.

- ☞ **That is our goal, to be a Bondservant:** Someone who has made themselves a willing servant. Someone who knows by experience how greatly they are loved by Jesus, and has fallen in love with Him, and now never wants to leave His presence.

2 Peter

1 Simon Peter, a **bondservant** and **apostle** of Jesus Christ, To those who have obtained **like precious faith** with us by the **righteousness** of our **God and Savior Jesus Christ**:

- ☞ **An Apostle:** there are only 12 apostles. They had to witness the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. I believe Paul became the 12th apostle in replacement of Judas. Matthias was the choice of the other apostles in their flesh, but not God's choice.
- ☞ **To those who have obtained a Precious faith:** gr. "**Isotimon**" "**A valuable faith, faith worth a great price**". This faith you have to believe in Jesus, even it is a gift to you and it is a Faith purchased with the priceless blood of the creator of all things.
- ☞ **By the Righteousness of Jesus:** We have obtained our faith by the "**Righteousness**" of our God.

1 Corinthians 1:30

...Jesus, who **became for us ... righteousness**

2 Corinthians 5:21

For He made Jesus who knew no sin to become sin for us, **that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.**

Philippians 3:9

...That we might be found **in Jesus, not having our own righteousness**, NOTICE which is from the law, but that which is **through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God** by faith; (NKJ)

- ☞ **Righteousness that comes by our God and savior Jesus Christ:** literally in the Greek language: "**Theou heemoon kai sooteeros leesou christoy**" Peter says that he is an eyewitness, Someone who has seen Jesus face to face, and so tells us that Jesus is **both God and Savior.**

2 Peter 1

- 2 **Grace** and **peace** be **multiplied to you** NOTICE HOW **in the knowledge** of God and of Jesus our Lord,
- 3 as **His divine power has given to us all things** that pertain to life and godliness, **through the knowledge of Him** who **called us** by glory and virtue,

- ☞ **Grace:** "**Charis**" The Greeks always wished each other "**Grace**".
- ☞ **Peace:** "**Shalom**" the Jewish people wished each other "**Peace**".
- ☞ **The results** of experiencing the "*Grace of God*", Which is Getting the Forgiveness that we did not deserve, that causes us to experience the "*Peace of God.*" Peace even in the midst of turmoil going on all around us
- ☞ **This Grace and Peace is to be Multiplied To you:** gr. "**Plethos**" "**To increase in great number.**"
- ☞ **Verse 3: His divine power has given to us all things:** This is where all of your power comes from, **his unlimited resources, how vast are his resources?**

Jeremiah 51:15

He has **made the earth by His power;** he has **established** the world **by His wisdom,** and stretched out the heaven by His understanding.

Ephesians 1:19-20 Paul wrote to the believers at Ephesus:

19 I pray **that you will begin to understand the incredible greatness of his power for us who believe him.** This is the same mighty power

20 **that raised Christ from the dead** and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms

How great is the power that is available to you this morning? Power to help you with your problems, trials and everyday need of your life?

- ⊕ **Ephesians 1** says, "Oh, just the same power that it took to raise Jesus from the dead!"
- ⊕ **You see**, no matter what kind of help the world offers to you, it does not have the power to raise to life those things that have died.

Romans 4:17

God, who gives life to the dead and **calls those things which do not exist as though they did;**

- ⊕ **You might feel a little dead yourself** this morning (especially after listening to me for an hour)
- ⊕ **You might feel like your job, your marriage**, your relationships with people, your purpose in this life, is dead or dying.
- ⊕ **Perhaps you have been discouraged** in your walk with Jesus, because every time you turn around, you are failing and falling...

2 Peter 1

2 ...Jesus our Lord,

3 ... **His divine power has given to us all things** that pertain to life and godliness,

- ⊕ **As you continue to come and learn** more about Jesus, through our verse by verse study of Gods word, you will find that **Jesus has the power to raise to life, all those things that you might have thought were hopeless.**

His promise to you is that He will "Direct all of your paths if you will acknowledge Him in your life..."

Proverbs

3:6 In **all your ways** acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. (NKJ)

2 Peter 1

3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who **called us** by glory and virtue

- ⊕ **"Called us"**: gr. "**Kaleo**" "To invite someone."
- ⊕ **Jesus has been calling out to you** all of your life: "Come and Follow Me..."
- ⊕ **We have been invited** to become the children of God and to inherit every blessing and treasure that Jesus has.

One day, Jesus passed by a man that everyone hated during this time, A Tax collector, (Things haven't changed much) A man that probably felt like no one loved him, a man that felt like he would never turn out to be anything of great purpose...

Matthew 9:9

As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, **“Follow Me.” So he arose and followed Him.**

Matthew 16:24

Then Jesus said to His disciples, **“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.**

If you want to really change things in your life, if you want to really find meaning and purpose in your life, Right now, right where you are in your life, start following Jesus with ALL your heart.

- ⊖ **But if you are going to follow Jesus**, you must be willing to let go and surrender everything else in your life to Him.
- ⊖ **Take your life and hang it on the Cross with Jesus**, be willing to let go the control of everything into His able hands.
- ⊖ **This is what it means** to make Jesus “*Lord of your life*”. You cannot have Jesus just as Savior of your life, you must also allow Him to Be Lord OF EVERYTHING. “If Jesus is not Lord of All, He is not Lord at all”

John 5:26 Jesus Said:

For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son to have life in Himself,

John 5:40

But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.

John 10:10

...I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

2 Peter 1

4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious **promises**, that **through these** you may be partakers of **the divine nature**, having **escaped the corruption** that is in the world through lust.

- ⊖ **The Promises of God:** I have counted more than 300 promises that God has made to us.
- ⊖ **Did you know** that the answer to everyone of life's questions is found in the Bible. Every subject, everything you want to know about why you are here, why you were born, and what the purpose for you life is all about.

Verse 4: “Through these (Promises) you may be partakers of the divine nature...”

- ☞ **This is truly an amazing statement**, that you and I who have surrendered our lives to Jesus as Lord and Savior, will also partake ***of His Divine Nature***.

Genesis 1:27

So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

When we were originally made, we were just like God in our “*image*” The Hebrew Word “**Tselem**” (tseh’-lem), which means “**A shadow of something , Resembling something, a representative of something**”.

1 John 4:8 The primary attribute of God is His love...

He who does not love does not know God, for God is love

When we were originally created:

- ☞ **We loved** the way God loved.
- ☞ **We acted and behaved** like God acted and behaved.
- ☞ **We had all of the attributes** of Love, spoken of in 1 Corinthians 13:

1 Corinthians 13:4-7

4 Love **suffers long** and is **kind**; love does **not envy**; love does **not parade itself**, is **not puffed up**;

5 does **not behave rudely**, does **not seek its own**, is **not provoked**, **thinks no evil**;

6 does **not rejoice in iniquity**, but **rejoices in the truth**;

7 **bears all things**, **believes all things**, **hopes all things**, **endures all things**

We are all aware as I read this list of what love is, that none of us here this morning have these things consistently in our life.

Verse 4: “Through these (Promises) you may be partakers of **the divine nature**...”

- ☞ **The promise of God** is that right now, you are being conformed or shaped into the image of God again.
- ☞ **This will take your entire lifetime**, and someday be completed when you leave your body and are with Jesus.

1 John 3:2

Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that **when Jesus is revealed, we shall be like Him**, for we shall see Him as He is.

But, right now, every time you do one of those things that Jesus would do, you are “*Partaking of His Divine Nature*”, you are acting like God acts...

2 Peter 1

4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having **escaped the corruption** that is in the world through lust.

- ⊖ **Escaped the corruption**: this is a reference to death, eternal separation from God, you will escape.

Now here in verse 5, peter continues his call to us for Holiness.

2 Peter

5 But also for this very reason, giving all **diligence**, add to your faith **virtue**, to virtue **knowledge**,
6 to knowledge **self-control**, to self-control **perseverance**, to perseverance **godliness**,
7 to godliness **brotherly kindness**, and to brotherly kindness **love**.

Many times we want to know what we should be seeking to do, to become more and more like Jesus in our everyday life. This is what the Root meaning of "**Holiness**" is all about: **A Desire to become more and more like Jesus in our everyday life.**

- ⊖ **Verse 5: Start off with diligence**: you just keep trying, you never give up.
- ⊖ **Then add virtue**: you set standards for yourself, remember like Joseph, you think about things in advance, decide you will not do anything that will hurt the Lord. You live your life with goodness
- ⊖ **Then add knowledge**: add to your virtue the **Word of God**. As you know more about the character and nature of Jesus you will want to please him more and more. You will want to sin less and less.
- ⊖ **Then add self control**: the results of your increased knowledge of the word and his will for you is more personal self control.
- ⊖ **Then add perseverance**: a Continued determination, always seeking to improve, determining to not settle for the same old behavior, being so convinced of your direction, that you will remain in Jesus, and you will not be moved.
- ⊖ **Then add godliness**: a continuation in doing the things that Jesus would do everyday, even though there are many failures, these things results in a godly life.
- ⊖ **Then add brotherly kindness**: how do we treat those who are part of the body of Christ? These we are to love above all others.
- ⊖ **Then you will have Love**: the results of living a life determined in advance to do these things is love.
- ⊖ *Love is the greatest gift. 1 Corinthians . 13:13*

John 13:35 Jesus said:

"By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

Matt 22:37-38

37 Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

38 "This is the first and great commandment.

- ☞ **No matter where we might fail in other areas of our life.** If we just seek to love Jesus more than any other thing or person or place in our life and love other people, we have accomplished the full requirement of the law.

2 Peter

- 8 NOTICE: For **if these things are yours** (THOSE THINGS IN VERSE 7) and **abound**, IN ABUNDANCE **you will be neither barren nor unfruitful** in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 9 For he who **lacks these things** is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was NOTICE **cleansed from his old sins**.

- ☞ **If these things are yours:** Those things Peter describes in verse 7: **diligence, virtue, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, love.**
- ☞ **You will not be barren or unfruitful:** If you seek to add these 8 things to your life, the promise is that your life will be full and rich.
- ☞ **If you lack these things:** the warning is: if you lack these things, you are short sighted, You are missing out and have forgotten what Jesus has done for you, and how much He suffered for you.

Do you realize what the Jesus has done for you?

1. He has made you a new creation.
2. Your sin's will never be brought up again.
3. Every wrong thing, every mistake you have ever made is forgotten, it is as if it never happened.
4. You have eternal life. If you die today, you will live forever in paradise.
5. It will take eternity for Jesus to pour out into your life, all that He has planned for you.
6. You will see The Living God in His glory in full strength.
7. You will see heaven and all of the angels.
8. You will see again all those who have love the lord, including your family and friends who have died.
9. You will get to be with them forever, without the stresses and time limitations of earth, just endless time in fullness of joy.
10. You will reign with Jesus over the kingdoms of this earth for 1,000 years, judge the angels, have the mind of Christ.
11. You will witness the re creation of the Universe and have the opportunity to see and visit the entire universe for yourself.

2 Peter 1

- 10 Therefore, SO BECAUSE YOU KNOW THIS: brethren, **be even more diligent** to **make your call and election sure**, for if you do these things you will **never stumble**;
- 11 for so **an entrance** will be supplied to you abundantly into the **everlasting kingdom** of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Make your call and election sure:

1. **Calling:** The fact that you have been called to eternal life, to have your sin's forgiven and be reunited back to the Lord.
2. **Election:** because The Lord knew before He made anything else that you would make the decision to "**Choose**" Jesus, He "**Elected**" you to be conformed into the exact image of Jesus.
3. **So, Make your calling and election Sure:** We have to examine our own walk with Jesus, test our own claims that we make, and see if they are real and genuine, if there is evidence in our life that we really do know Jesus.

Now, if you have known Jesus for awhile, and you have thought about this subject of being both "**Called**" and "**Elected**", you probably have struggles with these two terms.

- ☞ **How can I be called and Elected by God** that is The Lord has complete control over everything in the Universe...
- ☞ **While at the same time** I have a free will to choose to accept Jesus as my Lord and Savior, or Reject Him?
- ☞ **Don't these two** conflict with each other?

How can I exercise my free will while at the same time, the Lord is really in control of everything?

Imagine for a minute that you are leaving next week on a vacation aboard the new Queen Mary 2, the largest, longest, tallest and widest passenger ship ever conceived.



At 1,132 feet, it is almost a 1/4 mile long, or about the same size as an Aircraft Carrier.
As tall as a 21 Story building.
Has 157,000 Horsepower
Cost over 800 million dollars to build.

You are departing from New York, headed to Liverpool England.

Now, the destination of the Ocean liner has been predetermined already, nothing is going to change that.

But while you are on board the Queen Mary, you won't be chained up to a pole, you won't be forced to do anything, you are completely free to move about the great ship, to go and do as you wish.

All the while you are aboard doing what you want, the ship is still headed for it's destination.

In this illustration you can see how both Your free will and Gods Sovereignty are working together at the same time.

The Bible teaches Both are true, Gods absolute control over everything, and Your responsibility to choose or reject Jesus yourself.

Acts 2:23

Jesus was being delivered **by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified**, and put to death;

So... *“Make your calling and election sure...”*

The promise then is that You will:

- ☞ **Never stumble:** if you make your calling and election sure by abiding or staying “Close to Jesus” you will never stumble.
- ☞ **Is it really possible** that a person can get to the point where they don’t stumble, **YES, not stumble as often**, by staying close to Jesus.

1 John 2:1

My little children, these things I write to you, **so that you may not sin**. And **if anyone sins**, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

- ☞ **An entrance into the everlasting kingdom:** the entrance into heaven is through Jesus.

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

- ☞ **Not just entrance into heaven,** but entrance into a place that is beyond your wildest dreams.

1 Corinthians 2:9

9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

- ☞ **If You Sat Down And Tried To Imagine** In Your Wildest Imagination How Wonderful Heaven Is, This Verse Says You Would Still Not Be Even Close, Heaven Is That Wonderful.

Psalms 16:11

11 You will show me the path of life; in Your presence is **fullness of joy**; at Your right hand are **pleasures forevermore**.

- ☞ What is the **“fullness of joy”** ?
- ☞ **Not just joy once in a while** like we have here on earth.

- ☞ **It is joy** that does not end.
- ☞ **That feeling you have** when you are totally happy, in heaven it will never end.
- ☞ **Pleasures forevermore:** pleasure and fulfillment are and every day part of your life.
- ☞ **And they too** will never end.
- ☞ **Can you imagine** a place where your joy never ends and everything you experience is full of pleasure?

What does heaven look like? I want to give you just a little Glimpse...

Revelation 4:1

After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet



Revelation 4:2-4

2 Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.
3 And He who sat there was like a jasper (**Clear, Bright**) and a sardius stone (**Red**) in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald. (**Green**)
4 Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads.



Revelation 4:5-8

5 And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.
6 Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back.



7 **The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.**

8 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying:

“Holy, holy, holy,
Lord God Almighty,

Who was and is and is to come!”

10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:

11 “You are worthy, O Lord,
To receive glory and honor and power;
For You created all things,
And by Your will they exist and were created.”



Ezekiel also saw heaven and these 4 living Creatures also, but from a different view than John:



Ezekiel 1:4-28

4 Then I looked, and behold, a whirlwind was coming out of the north, a great cloud with raging fire engulfing itself; and brightness was all around it and radiating out of its midst like the color of amber, out of the midst of the fire.

5 Also from within it came the likeness of **four living creatures**. And **this was their appearance**: they had **the likeness of a man**.

6 **Each one had four faces**, and each one had four wings.

7 Their legs were straight, and the soles of their feet were like the soles of calves' feet. They sparkled like the color of burnished bronze.

8 The hands of a man were under their wings on their four sides; and each of the four had faces and wings.

9 Their wings touched one another. The creatures did not turn when they went, but each one went straight forward.

10 **As for the likeness of their faces**, each had **the face of a man**, each of the four had **the face of a lion on the right side**, each of the four **had the face of an ox on the left side**, and each of the four had **the face of an eagle**.



11 Thus were their faces. Their wings were stretched upward; two wings of each one touched one another, and two covered their bodies.

12 And each one went straight forward; they went wherever the spirit wanted to go, and they did not turn when they went.

13 As for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like burning coals of fire, and like the appearance of torches. Fire was going back and forth among the living creatures; the fire was bright, and out of the fire went lightning.

14 And the living creatures ran back and forth, in appearance like a flash of lightning.

15 **Now as I looked at the living creatures, behold, a wheel was on the earth beside each living creature** with its four faces.



16 The appearance of the wheels and their workings was like the color of beryl, and all four had the same likeness. The appearance of their workings was, as it were, a wheel in the middle of a wheel.

17 When they went, they went toward any one of four directions; they did not turn aside when they went.

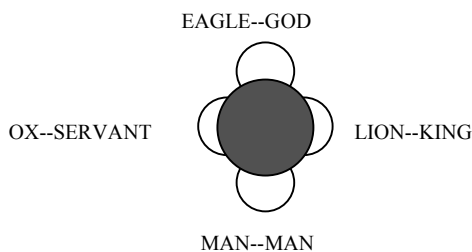
18 As for their rims, they were so high they were awesome; and their rims were full of eyes, all around the four of them.

19 When the living creatures went, the wheels went beside them; and when the living creatures were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up.

20 Wherever the spirit wanted to go, they went, because there the spirit went; and the wheels were lifted together with them, for the spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels.

21 When those went, these went; when those stood, these stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up together with them, for the spirit of the living creatures was in the wheels.

The 4 faces that Ezekiel saw of the cherubim in heaven:



Ezekiel is standing here

These are the same 4 Creatures that we saw in Revelation 4

Revelation 4

7 The first living creature was like a **lion**, the second living creature like a **calf**, the third living creature had a face like a **man**, and the fourth living creature was like a flying **eagle**.

The Lion



The Calf or Ox



The Man



The Eagle



And Amazingly, They are in the same order as the Book of revelation.

Even more amazing is the fact that the 4 Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John show these 4 faces of these Creatures in Heaven, through Jesus Ministry

- ☞ **The Holy Spirit** used each of these 4 views to reveal to us—the 4 natures—or purposes of Jesus—to us—as he came to earth.

The 4 Gospels:

1. **Matthew**—portrays Jesus as “**The King**”—the “**Lion**” of the tribe of Judah”. Matthew was writing specifically to the Jewish people to prove that Jesus was their king. Matthew uses the phrase “***That it might be fulfilled***”, 9 times when he wrote his gospel to show the Jewish readers how Jesus fulfilled over 300 of their prophecies in the old testament about the Messiah.

2. **Mark**—portrays Jesus as a “**The Servant**”—“**The Ox**”—as Isaiah reveals Jesus as the servant in the old testament Mark is believed to be “**The first gospel**” written. **Mark also reveals Jesus as a servant**, who like Isaiah, writes that Jesus purpose in coming this first of two times was to lay down his life for us, to die for us, to pay the penalty we deserved for our sin. Mark shows Jesus as this Ox a servant and by giving his life Jesus was able to minister to our physical and spiritual needs.
3. **Luke**—portrays Jesus as “**The Man**” Luke was a medical doctor, very familiar with man, and so he writes very specifically **to the Gentiles** to show that Jesus can identify with all of us because he was a man. Luke shows Jesus compassion and love for us, his ability to understand your life, your trials. Luke emphasizes the work of the Holy Spirit in Jesus life.
4. **John**—portrays Jesus as “**God**” “**The Eagle**”—the main purpose of Johns gospel was to prove that Jesus was in fact God. John focuses on the spiritual meaning behind everything that Jesus did rather than on the action itself. John describes Jesus as “**Life—and light**”. He uses words like “**Believe—and witness**” because he wants for us to know for certain that Jesus is the eternal God, the creator of everything that exists, and how Jesus stepped out of eternity into time to rescue us. John records Jesus 7 miraculous signs, for the sole purpose of establishing the evidence that Jesus is God by the proof of these 7 miraculous signs that Jesus did.
